Nursing Special Interest Group (SIG) Clinical Excellence Award

A Clinical Excellence Award will be awarded to an ASBMT Nursing SIG member who has made a significant impact in the field of blood and marrow transplantation nursing or achieved a professional milestone. The Clinical Excellence Award will recognize an individual who has made high quality contributions to the field of blood and marrow transplantation including publications, presentations, mentoring, volunteering in professional organizations, serving in leadership positions within professional organizations, implementation of an evidence based practice change, significant contribution to unit based committees or achievement of BMTCN.

The recipient of this award will receive a recognition plaque to be presented at the annual nursing conference at the TANDEM ASBMT/CIBMTR meeting. Additionally, the conference registration fee will be waived for that year's conference.

Eligibility:

Must be a current member of ASBMT.

Points will be awarded as follows:

Publications	Journal article = 5 points/article Book Chapter = 10 points/chapter Abstract = 2 points/abstract
Presentations	5 points/presentation
Mentoring	10 points/mentee
Volunteering in Professional organization	10 points/year
Leadership Position in Professional organization or within Institution	15 points/year
Implementation of an Evidence Based Practice Change	10 points/initiative
Significant Contributions to Unit Based Committees	5 points
Achieved BMTCN	10 points
Recruiting new members	5 points/member
