

## **Committee on RFI**

### **Mission Statement**

The Committee is charged with achieving standardized methods of reporting data to third-party payers, and standardized procedures for replying to requests for information from payers.

### **Current Goals**

1. Recruit payer participation in the value assessment of the ASBMT RFI.
2. Modify the RFI yearly considering changes in the field and be responsive to programs' concern about the potential for misinterpretation of outcome data by payers with a release of a revised RFI version every February post Tandem meetings.
3. Be responsive to BMT program questions on how to complete the RFI and submit updates to payers at the biennial UNOS meeting.

### **Ongoing Objectives**

1. Determine capacity of the CIBMTR for some form of electronic capture of RFI data elements. The intent being for a web-based solution.
2. Approach payers with the intent of determining their use of the RFI and their preferred mode for receiving the information.
3. Revise the 2016 RFI to incorporate transplant center recommendations for clarifying the completion instructions.
4. Recommend new members and those that are to roll-off committee membership.
