The ASBMT Pharmacy SIG Working Committee member selection process is as follows:

A. Candidates. Any member of the ASBMT Pharmacy SIG is eligible to serve on a working committee. Pharmacists in the community as well as all current members of the ASBMT Pharmacy SIG will be notified of upcoming vacancies by the Steering Committee.

1. Interested candidates must complete and submit an ASBMT Pharmacy SIG Working Committee Nomination Form and attach a copy of their curriculum vitae (CV).

2. Candidates for working committee membership must provide full disclosure of potential conflicts of interest prior to appointment.

B. Re-Appointments. Current working committee members interested in re-appointment must also notify the Steering Committee by February 1, 2017. As noted, an existing member may serve a second consecutive term only in the event that no other qualified individuals are nominated.

C. Appointing Committee. Appointments to the working committees will be determined by the current voting members of the Steering Committee. The Steering Committee will review completed Committee Nomination Forms and CVs of interested candidates during February of 2016 and will appoint candidates to a working committees.

- B. Completion of committee assignments
